Special Meeting of Borough Council
Held in Council Chambers, 35 Union Street, Morrisville PA
Wednesday, November 12, 2009

Those in attendance were President Nancy Sherlock, Vice President Kathryn Panzitta, Edward Bailey, Jane Burger, Eileen Dreisbach, Rita Ledger, Dave Rivella, Acting Borough Manager Dorothy Gaydula and Police Chief Jack Jones. Mayor Tom Wisnosky and Councilperson Steve Worob were absent.

Council-elect representatives were also present at the Budget Sessions.

This meeting was scheduled as a budget session. The meeting opened at 7:13pm

Chief Jones would like to make the corporal position into a supervisor and he would like to hire a new officer. The officer would work either the 3-11 or the 11-7 shift. This person would be able to do more paperwork also.

We discussed salary...\$34,891 and about \$20,000 in benefits

*Note, the difference between the lieutenant and the corporal is the same difference as the officer and the corporal.

MOPEC – The Borough will be responsible for the cost of this training this year.

Chief is also asking that we raise the part timer's salary to \$19.00 per hour.

The gang grant balance was \$10,000 at the end of October; it can be used for gang training, equipment and OT

Other requests from the Chief were:

- New lockers \$2,500
- Cameras in the parking lot, hallway & front desk \$3,500
- Two new desks \$4,200
- Computers \$4,200

Our local District Judge is considering a 10pm to 2am shift

The cost of new vests will be handled by the vest grant.

This wish list totals \$14,100 -\$15,500

A motion to adjourn was made by Eileen Dreisbach and seconded at 8:43 pm

Motion carried 7-0 by voice vote.

Immediately following this budget session there was an executive session regarding personnel.
