

**Borough of Morrisville**  
**Special Meeting**  
**Held in Council Chambers, 35 Union Street, Morrisville, PA**  
**Tuesday, December 15, 2009**

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, Mrs. Gaydula took roll call, those present were: President Nancy Sherlock, Vice President Kathryn Panzitta, Edward Bailey, Jane Burger, Eileen Dreisbach, Rita Ledger, Dave Rivella, Steve Worob, Acting Borough Manager Dorothy Gaydula, Acting Assistant Borough Manager Robert Seward, and Solicitor James Downey. Mayor Tom Wisnosky was absent.

An announcement was made that there would be an executive session held at the end of the meeting regarding negotiations and personnel.

**Hearing of the Public**

**John Eperjesi :** John is looking for the Council to enact a noise ordinance. The town is too loud; the car stereos are too loud. Today he was bothered by a man dressed as Santa singing in front of the smoke shop.

**Bill Setzer:** Bill was at the zoning meeting and feels that the neighbors in the area of the Cloverleaf are correct in not wanting the new housing development; he would feel that same way if it were his neighborhood. Wanted to know what the \$500,000 that Bob White mentioned was all about and where did it come from? Will a traffic study be done? They may need a traffic light there.

At this time Nancy Sherlock read a statement regarding Cloverleaf and Mr. Downey gave an overview, he explained the process and explained the fact that before Council could address any of their concerns, the developer would have to come before the Zoning Board. Motion made by Jane Burger and seconded. Motion passes by voice vote 8-0.

#2 Motion to authorize purchase of the TopKAT Fuel Management System from J.W. Scott Equipment Co. in the amount of \$7,088.70. Motion made by Dave Rivella and seconded. Motion passes by voice vote 8-0.

#3. Motion to authorize the proper Borough Officials to sign the revised Maintenance Agreement with the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission for the median island on East Bridge, as revised, and requested by the on December 3, 2009 DRJTBC. Motion made by Jane Burger and seconded. Motion passed by voice vote 8-0.

**Discussion by Borough Officials:**

The Memorandum of Understanding for the Dog Park was discussed, also discussed some of the rules that needed to be changed.

Ed Bailey went over the library state aid formula and explained why we need to spend more money on books.

Rita Ledger made an announcement about a Landmark Towns commercial that is airing on the Hallmark Channel. Channel 133 or 135.

Nancy Sherlock made an announcement about an opportunity for an intern at the Landmark Towns main office in Bristol. It would include office duties and marketing.

Dorothy Gaydula made an announcement about the Census Bureau and their request to use the Borough Hall for some of their testing and also to meet with citizens that may not be able to meet at their home. They have sent a letter and Dorothy is handling the particulars. The hours will be posted.

Jane Burger mentioned that in the future we should try not to have Committee meetings on the same night.

Eileen Dreisbach asked if we can check on Delmorr Avenue and the DRJTBC work along the river. Robert Seward said he would follow up the next day.

Nancy Sherlock announced that the Policy Meeting scheduled for this week is cancelled.

Motion to adjourn was made by Dave Rivella and seconded. Motion passed by voice vote 8-0. Meeting was adjourned at 9:41 pm, followed by the Executive Session
