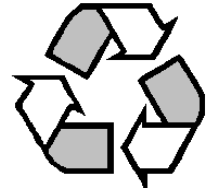


# Morrisville Borough Recycling Guidelines



## **Containers – Glass, Plastic, & Cans**

**(The three items below can all be placed loosely together in any open-top plastic container. Mark container “Recycle” if possible.)**

### **ITEMS ACCEPTED**

- ❑ **Glass Bottles and Jars.** Clear, green, and brown glass food & beverage jars & bottles. Remove lids, empty, & rinse. Do not break.

---

- ❑ **Plastic Bottles.** Plastic bottles with a neck and a #1 or #2 in an arrow triangle on the bottom or side. From food, beverage, & detergent. Remove and discard lids, empty, & rinse. Can be crushed.

---

- ❑ **Aluminum, Steel, Tin, and Bi-metal Cans.** From food & beverage. Empty & rinse. Can be crushed.

### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED**

- ⇒ ❑ Light bulbs, dishes, window & auto glass, ceramics, mirrors, crystal, or cookware.

---

- ⇒ ❑ Tubs, bins, lids, bags, wrap, styrofoam, toys, #3 - #7, auto oil bottles, utensils, cups, or dishes.

---

- ⇒ ❑ Aerosol cans, aluminum foil, trays, or siding, paint cans, or scrap metal.

## **Paper**

**(The two items below should be bundled separately. These can then also be placed in any open-top plastic container. Mark container “Recycle” if possible.)**

### **ITEMS ACCEPTED**

- ❑ **Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, and Phone Books.** Preferred clean & dry. Tie in bundles or place in brown paper grocery bags. (No plastic bag over paper bag.)

---

- ❑ **Mixed Paper.** Any color office paper, junk mail, or envelopes. Preferred clean & dry. Place in brown paper grocery bags.

### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED**

- ⇒ ❑ Plastic bags, waxed paper, food and beverage wrappers, cardboard, paperboard, or dirty paper.

---

- ⇒ ❑ Plastic bags, string, waxed paper, food and beverage wrappers, cardboard, paperboard, or dirty paper.
