



On Saturday September 24, Audubon Pennsylvania will be hosting a stream clean-up in and along Willis Run in York. The group will meet at 9am – 12pm along the nature trail in Noonan Park (near the corner of Maryland Avenue and Wood Street). Audubon will provide all of the necessary supplies, but feel free to bring your own gloves and boots. This event is one of many happening during the Watershed Alliance of York's 14th annual Watershed Weekend.

Willis Run is a tributary of Codorus Creek and the Susquehanna River. It also feeds into Kiwanis Lake, which is an Important Bird Area and the home of three state endangered birds including the great egret. Cleaning up Willis Run is essential for the protection of the habitat for these birds. We hope to see you there!





One Cool Garden Critter

Recently I found a rather ragged looking caterpillar on some cranberry viburnum (*Viburnum trilobum*). Frankly, it looked half dead and desiccated. With some help from Facebook, it was identified as that of the Harris' three spot moth (*Harismemna trisignata*), a striking mottled black, white and brown moth. The caterpillar, I would learn, has some amazing adaptations. From the back, its coloration and features mimic a jumping spider, poised with fangs exposed. It's messy coat of hair resembles the filaments of an airborne seed, some tangled spider webs or a bird dropping.

But the real magic is in this critter's keeping of its discarded head capsules (upon molting) which it retains in a strand of towering "maces." When threatened, the caterpillar swings this chained mace wildly in an attempt to strike a potential intruder or evade capture. Check out the video linked below for the action! 
