HEARING OF THE PUBLIC

ACTION ITEMS

Discussion ensued regarding the proposed budget.

Mr. Mitchell stated, okay, if that's it, we will make the minor changes we talked about Thursday night, we will repackage this and have it for your approval Monday night as a proposed budget. You can still make changes and some numbers will still shift because we're still working on a few things like health insurance that will change prior to the final budget.

Mr. Mitchell stated the only changes to the fee schedule were the ones we discussed at the budget meeting. I believe it was trash collection, road opening permits, fees for Fire Marshal reports, and other minor edits, basically things we didn't address in the two previous versions have now been updated so the fee schedule is complete and ready for 2020. We also added the short-term lodging facility license, per the new ordinance.

Discussion ensued with regard to having the annual community service day at the Library in 2020.
