



6:00 Executive Session – Regarding Police Negotiations, Personnel, and Litigation

The Morrisville Borough Council met on Wednesday, November 30, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at the Morrisville Municipal Building, 35 Union Street, Morrisville, PA for a Special Council Meeting.

1. Attendance

2. Budget Discussion

- Mrs. Danko informed Council that the MMA will provide us with \$400,000 a year for two years and the agreement will be renewable every two years. This will not be called a service agreement and it will not require the Borough to do monthly reports. Mrs. Danko will still be coding expenses under water.
- Mrs. Danko provided Council with the wage data sheet, it includes hiring a police officer that is listed as a truck enforcement officer and a confidential secretary for Mrs. Danko.
- Mrs. Danko suggests that we take all salaries out of Liquid Fuels and use that money to do streets.
- Mrs. Sherlock suggests that when the timing is right Council should take out a loan of maybe \$1.5 million and do a comprehensive street program.
- New millage rate is 61,372.
- Medical benefits will be 2.5%.



- All other insurances will remain the same as it was in 2022.
- Discussion ensued regarding the library budget. Mrs. Danko said the salaries must come down.
- Mrs. Sherlock asked a number of questions about the final budget and asked if Council will get a copy before they meet to vote on the preliminary budget next Wednesday. Mrs. Danko confirmed that Council will have it by next Tuesday.
