**Morrisville Borough**, offices located at **35 Union Street, Morrisville, PA 19067**, will receive sealed bids online until **11:00 A.M.**, prevailing time on **October 17, 2019** at which time and place the bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud for:

**Contract 2018-0705101: MORRISVILLE BOROUGH HISTORIC SUMMERSEAT ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS – PHASE II**

This project consists of the installation of ADA/PennDOT compliant curb ramps, with all necessary sidewalks, curbing, storm inlets and sign relocation/installation along Harper Avenue, Clymer Avenue and Legion Avenue at Historic Summerseat within Morrisville Borough. All material, labor, and equipment necessary shall be in accordance with PennDOT Publication 408 and Borough Standards.

All bidding documents and solicitation details may be obtained at PennBid™ [www.ebidexchange.com/pennbid](http://www.ebidexchange.com/pennbid). Click on the “Solicitations” then “View” tabs. All documents, specifications, and drawings can be obtained and secure bids submitted online at no cost. A nominal fee of 0.33% of the bid amount (up to \$5,000) is assessed only to bidders who are awarded the contracts. For bidders who are not the winning bid; there are absolutely no fees.

Each bid shall be submitted in accordance with the instructions to Bidders and must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Check for not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount payable to **Morrisville Borough** along with an Agreement of Surety certifying that the required Performance and Payment Bonds will be provided to the Bidder.

The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish proof of insurance and bonds for Performance, Payment, and Maintenance in such form as meets the approval of **Morrisville Borough** and having as security thereon such Surety company or companies as are approved by **Morrisville Borough**

The work to be performed under this Agreement is a project assisted under a program providing direct Federal financial assistance from HUD and it's subject to the requirements of Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended (12 U.S.C. 1702). Section 3 requires that to the greatest extent feasible opportunities for training and employment be given to low-and very low-income residents of the project area, and that contracts for work in connection with the project be awarded to business concerns that provide economic opportunities for low- and very low-income persons residing in the metropolitan area in which the project is located.

The Bidder's attention is called to the fact that the project is receiving funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and that the Davis-Bacon Act applies to this Contract and the successful Bidder shall pay no less than the **Federal Wage Rates** determined for the project area as set forth in the Contract Documents. The successful Bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex or national origin. The completion of all CDBG Non-Discrimination Documents must also be submitted at the time of the bid. This project is subject to applicable requirements of the Borough's Responsible Contractor Ordinance for work valued at over Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000).

No Bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening of the bids.

**Morrisville Borough** reserves the right to reject any and all bids for any cause whatsoever, to eliminate any item or items from the contract, and to waive any informality in the bids.
