Construction Activities Scheduled on Route 32 (Bridge Street) for Local Safety Improvement Project in Morrisville Borough

King of Prussia, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced today that construction activities are scheduled on Route 32 (Bridge Street) in Morrisville Borough, Bucks County, under a local project to improve safety and mobility along the Delaware Canal Towpath.

Motorists are advised of the following travel restriction:

- Monday, June 26, through late November, a periodic lane closure with flagging is scheduled on Route 32 (Bridge Street) between Pennsylvania Avenue and Morris Avenue.

Motorists are advised to allow extra time when traveling through the work area because backups and delays will occur. All scheduled activities are weather dependent.

Motorists can check conditions on more than 40,000 roadway miles by visiting www.511PA.com. 511PA, which is free and available 24 hours a day, provides traffic delay warnings, weather forecasts, traffic speed information and access to more than 1,000 traffic cameras.
